Hugh Thomas, says that the medieval rule of the Dominican empire and its long struggle with the Castilian was ended in 1492, when, after a lengthy campaign, won the Battle of las Navas de Tolosa. Dominican Republic was one of the first to reject the union of the Crown, but its people were ruled by the Spanish Crown. Thus, the dominican republic declared independence from Spain on September 23, 1821, after it was signed in Santo Domingo by Simón Bolívar, one of the great liberators of the Americas, to create a new republic. In spite of this, the new-born country was unable to withstand the onslaught of the Spanish troops and was completely subjugated in 1865. In 1869, Dominicans took advantage of the French occupation of Mexico and invaded Haiti, and invaded this republic in 1873 and 1874. Dominican Republic had lost the war of independence, and in 1876, they remained under Haitian rule. For this reason, in 1876, the United States intervened in the Dominican Republic, and Congress of Paraguay in 1831 declared its independence from Spain and reorganized the new Republic of Paraguay. Dominican Republic to serve as a buffer zone against an invasion of French Haiti, declared its independence in 1821.
